The diverse menu features everything from appetizers and wraps to hot subs, burgers, and specialty dinners.

Under Ronnie's ownership, the restaurant underwent several key renovations, including the addition of the Notre Dame room in 1988, and widescreen TVs in 2006. Now owned by his son, Jeff Snyder, Ronnie's Cedar Inn continues its tradition of providing a great dining and sports-watching experience while staying true to its rich history.
